Tomato	<i>Fusarium (Fusarium oxysporum f. sp. lycopersici)</i>	Soil drench Drip chemigation	3-4 quarts per acre	For soil drench applications apply this product as a soil drench following transplant or through chemigation. For application through sprinkler or sub-surface drip irrigation, apply at a concentration of 3 - 4 quarts per acre at seeding or transplant in up to 100 gallons of water, and in sufficient water to thoroughly soak the growing media and root zone. Make an initial application of this product during or shortly after transplant to reduce transplant shock, suppress <i>Fusarium oxysporum</i> and improve root growth. Multiple applications can be made on a 10- to 21-day interval. Applications can be made in-season through sub-surface drip irrigation.
STARGUS® has a <b>pre-harvest interval (PHI) of 0 days.</b> Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the <b>restricted-entry interval (REI) of 4 hours.</b>
